“Sweet Emotions” is the second book of the Song Trilogy by Jan Bornstein. When we catch up with rock stars Scott Tenny and Jenna Bradford, they are still together, and their relationship seems stronger than ever after all of the adversity they had faced in the first novel in the series. The couple is mingling both their personal and professional lives at a rabid pace, and their music, much to the delight of their friends and family, is better than ever. Scott and Jenna seem to be on a roller coaster that is on its way to the top, but as anyone who has ridden a roller coaster knows, there will eventually be a descent, and many more ups, downs, twists, and turns to follow. Such is life.

Bornstein writes her characters in an entirely believable manner that allows the reader to really connect with what each is going through. We suffer with them through tragedy, and smile with them during times of joy.
